

AMERICAN COLLEGIATE ROWING ASSOCIATION ELIGIBILITY NOTIFICATION

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES: Due to the significant impact on rosters and programs over the past two seasons, the ACRA Board has revised our eligibility guidelines for the 2022 ACRA Championship Regatta. A full description of the ACRA Regatta Eligibility rules can be found in the Regatta Packet on pages 7-8.

NOVICE ELIGIBILITY: Any athlete that started their collegiate competition from Fall, 2019 or later remains eligible for Novice competition in the 2022 ACRA Championship Regatta.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY: An athlete at the ACRA Championship Regatta typically has four years of eligibility to compete within five years of starting their first semester at a collegiate institution. Due to the impact of COVID-19, the 2020 and 2021 season of competition is forgiven even if an athlete was able to race. Any athlete attending a collegiate institution during the fall of 2019 through the spring of 2021 will have six years to complete their four years of eligibility.
