## ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATION AMERICAN COLLEGIATE ROWING ASSOCIATION

This form must be signed by the coach of each rowing program intending to compete in the ACRA Championship Regatta, and by the appropriate university official (Athletics, Student Affairs, Campus Recreation, etc.) and returned to ACRA prior to participation. Every competitor must meet all eligibility requirements as outlined in the regatta packet (see **www.regattacentral.com**). In brief, these are some of the highlights, but *please review the full document*.

Each participant must be a full time undergraduate student in a degree-seeking program, and must be making satisfactory progress toward that degree. Some graduate students may have eligibility; please refer to the section on eligibility in the regatta packet.

An ACRA competitor has four years of eligibility, which must be completed during 10 semester or 15 quarters("five years to row four"). Competing in any one event in an academic year is enough to constitute one year of eligibility.

To row in a novice event, a competitor must be in his/her first year of collegiate rowing.

Appeals for exceptions to these rules must be referred to the ACRA Eligibility Committee prior to the entry deadline. Documentation may be required.

Violations of regulations may be cause for crew or team disqualification. Unusually serious violations may be grounds for even more sanctions.
